Professional Development

Professional Development: To successfully implement any curriculum to fidelity, teachers need both training and ongoing coaching. Professional learning and coaching are integral for teachers to learn and internalize a curriculum to work with all children and families. HighScope provides ongoing teacher training and coaching, led by HighScope Certified Trainers, grounded in adult learning principles and imbedded in HighScope's active learning principles. HighScope's own research on its comprehensive training has shown increased quality provided for children and families as well as improved child outcomes. HighScope offers comprehensive and responsive professional development, both online and face-to-face, to caregivers and teachers, as well as to the administrators who support them.

Face-to-Face Trainings: HighScope offers a variety of face-to-face trainings (1–2 days; 1–4 weeks). HighScope's 4 week curriculum courses (infant-toddler; preschool) lay a foundation for teachers to begin implementing the curriculum in their classrooms. Throughout face-to-face trainings, teachers collaborate, demonstrate, and apply the knowledge they are learning to their own classrooms, children, and teaching practices.

Online Training Courses: HighScope's online courses (3–4 weeks) offer unmatched one-on-one support for individuals at all experience levels. Each course features active engagement and collaboration while providing practical application, inspiring ideas, and effective strategies that can be immediately applied in the classroom. It is estimated that teachers will need to spend at least 2–3 hours per week to complete assignments and discussions. Teachers can log in at any time during the week to complete their work, however, the courses adhere to the designated dates for completion. Because of our moderated approach to online courses, pre-enrollment is required at least one week prior to the start date, and the content of the course is offered the following 2–3 weeks. Courses run throughout the year.



Additional professional development:

- HighScope Teacher Certification: When teachers have achieved a level of fidelity they can apply for certification, which empowers them as teachers and educators of the children and families they work serve. Certification lasts three years at which time teachers recertify.
- HighScope Membership (www.highscope.org): Membership, which is free, offers teachers and educators access to additional resources, such as publications related to the curriculum and early childhood topics, and video clips of the curriculum in action. Coaches and trainers can also use these resources to support and extend the implementation of the curriculum to fidelity.
- COR 360 by HighScope (<https://360.coradvantage.com/>): COR 360, which is free, is a collection of high-quality tools and resources for early childhood educators. From strategies teachers can implement now, to opportunities to grow professionally and a community of fellow educators to support teachers, COR 360 will strengthen the quality of practice and programs.
- HighScope's Annual International Conference: The conference takes place each year in the spring and is an opportunity for those in the field to gather for three days of hands-on professional learning related to best practices in the field, latest trends, and strategies that empower the educator and ensure high-quality education for children from birth to age 5 and beyond.

Ongoing Professional Development Options and Costs
